DISTRICT VICE-PRESIDENT - SOUTHERN - nominated from the Southern Region
DISTRICT VICE-PRESIDENT - METALLIFEROUS - nominated from the Far Western Region
DISTRICT CHECK INSPECTOR - WESTERN - nominated from the Western Region
DISTRICT CHECK INSPECTOR – SOUTHERN - nominated from the Southern Region
DISTRICT RELIEF CHECK INSPECTOR - WESTERN - nominated from the Western Region
DISTRICT RELIEF CHECK INSPECTOR - SOUTHERN - nominated from the Southern Region

AREA 3 (1 position) - PKCT, Dendrobium Washery, Russell Vale Mine, Wongawilli Mine, Coal Samplers, Southern Mines Rescue Station, Illawarra CSPL or members employed by contract/labour hire companies within the Southern mining region.

WESTERN REGION (4 positions):

AREA 1 (1 position) - Ulan Underground Mines

AREA 2 (1 position) - Western Region Open Cut Mines

AREA 3 (1 position) - Springvale Mine, Airly Mine or Angus Place Mine

AREA 4 (1 position) - Clarence Mine or Rescue Station
